Twelve students (we had one automatic qualifier) from seven Orange County High Schools qualified for the National Chemistry Olympiad competition, of which four finished with High Honors (top 50 in the nation). Only one other Local Section (Indiana) out of the 144 competing Local Sections in the U.S. had more.
