The typical replacement cost for a diesel glow plug will be anywhere from \$95 to \$210. The cost of an individual glow plug will \$15 to \$50 while the cost of the labor will be about \$80 to \$160. Keep in mind that each cylinder has its own glow plug so if you have a full size truck with a V8 engine, you may want to consider replacing all eight glow plugs even if only one plug is known to be bad.

Making sure that the right quality glow plugs are put in your vehicle is important in keeping it consistent and reliable. Locate the glow plugs and remove as much dirt etc as possible from around them so it doesn't go down the hole when you get the plug out. Remove the wire connectors. Unscrew the glow plug using a well fitting tool. Long reach hex sockets are the best. Be very careful not to chew the head or you won't get it out. Clean the hole as best you can.

Remove the new spark plugs from their container and apply a coat of anti-seize compound to the threads. Then, carefully hand start the spark plugs back into the cylinder well. Once they are hand started, further tighten with the spark plug socket and socket wrench. It is also advised to check the spark plug's tension with a tension testing tool.
